
2020 Senior Stationery Requirements \$60

Dear parents and carers

In 2019 we trialled a different approach to stationery and backpack requirements for students in the Senior School.

Students were asked to provide their own pencil case items and rather than each student purchasing their individual classroom items, for a small payment the school provided stationery and exercise books to the teacher as required. This method proved successful with teachers able to access what they wanted immediately anytime throughout the year. This has minimised the need for students to have 'spare' books or folders that may not get used during the year.

Even though chromebooks and school computers can be used in many subjects, they are used to support student learning. Exercise books and stationery are still a vital requirement of education and learning.

The items that are required for every student, in every year level are listed below. These are pencil case items that we ask you to provide for your child and to maintain availability during the year by replacing if necessary. These items are available in any department or supermarket store.

For a cost to you of \$60 for the year, the school will supply these and other necessary resources required for your child's learning.

Alternatively, you are welcome to personally purchase the classroom resources to be used by your child. The minimum required would be at least an exercise book for each subject studied, a display folder for electives, subject specific exercise books as well as online subscription charges, copy paper and tissues. Please bring your backpack items to school with you during the first few days of school next year, including payment of \$15 for the online mathspace program.

Elective contribution charges are also necessary to keep up with subject demand of consumables used. Wood and metal, fresh food and groceries, clay, paints and paper, and online subscriptions are all ongoing costs necessary to provide a wide scope of electives. Passion projects cover a range of student interests and can also require funds to be able to supply necessary provisions to students. Please contribute to the elective costs of those your child is studying so we can maintain the high standard of materials used and the elective choices available.
